The 2017 summer school dates have been set! In an effort to avoid the typical "summer slide" (students not retaining the instructional information gained), we are stretching out our summer school schedule a little bit. Summer school will be a total of five weeks instead of four, but there will be no school on Monday, July 3 and Tuesday, July 4.

- June 19-July 21 summer school-AM and PM options available (Free breakfast/lunch served and transportation provided)
- July 3 and July 4-no school

Important Information

- **Registration:** Registering students in grades 3-8 for summer school classes will once again take place in our Infinite Campus Portal. Students currently in grades 4K-2nd will not need to register for classes as there is only one option for them (i.e. bridging to classes)
- **Swimming Lessons:** We are still offering swimming lessons as a part of summer school. Parents will be able to sign their child up for one of the following two week options:
 - June 19-30 (summer school in session)
 - July 5-14 (summer school in session)
 - July 17-28 (summer school in session the first week, **but** not the second week)
 - Swimming lesson information and registration will be available electronically and in person once again this year.
- **Breakfast/Lunch:** We will continue to offer the the free breakfast and lunch program as a part of summer school. This is a wonderful program for all of our students and we are reimbursed based on the number of students who participate.
- **PM Sports:** Once again we are planning to offer some of our sport option classes in the afternoon for students in grades 3-8. We are currently working on updating our Summer School Booklet and when that is done, you will be able to view the afternoon class options and schedules. Paper copies of the Summer School Booklet will also be available in all offices. The classes are either going to be for 3rd-5th graders or 6th-8th graders, and will either be an hour and a half or three hours long. There will be no transportation provided after these classes. There will be **no** PM sport option classes offered the week of July 3.
- **Transportation:** We will run morning and lunch hour transportation once again this year. More information on the times and locations of our summer school bus stops will be located in the online Summer School Booklet. Once again, paper copies will be available in all of the offices.
- **Remedial Session:** This year we are continuing to offer our elementary (grades 5K-5th) remedial option for two weeks. The dates are August 7-18. Students participate by invite only and parents will be contacted if we are recommending that their child participate.
- **High School:** This new schedule will not affect the high school summer school class offerings (Peak Performance, HS remedial, HS PE credit, HS band, and Ag.).
