

**MONDOVI MIDDLE SCHOOL
2016-2017 BUILDING GOALS**

- 1) **Mondovi Middle School will focus on student academic growth as measured by the STAR screening test that students take three times per year. While the Star tests are not the “be all, end all” measure of what our students are learning, they are a tangible metric we can base a school improvement goal upon.**

Goals: Between the fall and spring assessment periods, 75% of Mondovi Middle School students will achieve the STAR test projected typical growth benchmarks in reading and math. The staff will move toward offering interventions and enrichment in all MSR classrooms. (In 2015-16 60% achieved the typical growth benchmark in math, and 41% in reading).

Math

14-15: 68% of our students met the expected growth

15-16: 60% of our students met the expected growth

Reading

14-15: 55% of our students met the expected growth

15-16: 41% of our students met the expected growth

- 2) **The Mondovi Middle School’s implementation of the PBIS (Positive Behavior Intervention and Support) system will result in a continued reduction in the average per day office referral rate to below 1.5.**

In Year 1 of MMS PBIS program implementation the average per day office referral rate was 5.73 (2010/11),

Year 2- 3.3, Year 3- 2.59, Year 4 - 2.77,

Year 5 – 2.20, Year 6 – 1.59.
